Larry's career highlight came in the summer with the publication of *Rebuilt from Broken Glass: A German Jewish Life Remade in America* (Purdue University Press, 2017), a memoir he coauthored with Holocaust survivor Fred Behrend. Larry spoke about the book at the FJMC's international convention in Washington, D.C., in July, including an FJMC-arranged event to present a copy to the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum. The authors have made numerous appearances for synagogues, men's clubs and other groups throughout the region. The book has been recommended by the New Jersey Commission on Holocaust Education and sold out its initial print run.

Larry was an award-winning reporter and editor for *The Times of Trenton* (New Jersey) from 1988 to 2006 and worked briefly for the *Courier-Post* of Cherry Hill (N.J.). He has written on subjects as diverse as the anthrax crisis after the 9/11 attacks, education, politics, and professional sports. He later served as senior public relations manager for the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (2006-2010).
